I'd like you to walk with us in support of Canadian Unity. Our country—a united Canada—is in danger of disintegration. There are now at least three significant forces organized to tear us apart:

1. Alberta's vote for separation—first vote October 19th, 2026.

Reports show that Trump officials have ongoing meetings with Alberta's separatists.

2. A renewed promise of a Quebec independence referendum should the Parti Québécois come to power.

Vote likely 2027 or after Trump leaves office.

3. President Trump's vision to impose the Monroe Doctrine and force Canada into a union with the U.S by applying tariffs to strangle Canada economically.

On September 6th, 2026, Trump revealed a map where the U.S. flag is planted on a Canadian map and shows the change to Lake America instead of Lake Ontario.
